The journalism programme at University Campus Suffolk (UCS) is offering a Digital Freelancing and Features module in Spring 2013 with an emphasis on arts writing.

The module will serve new and practicing journalists with an interest in the arts as well as artists who want to develop a writing speciality.

Reviewers, critics and practitioners in fields including studio art, music, film, theatre and book writing will lecture on the module, which can be taken separately or as part of the MA Journalism course, which starts in Autumn 2013.

Participants will produce articles and reviews that engage with critical issues and learn to market their work to editors and publish it online. Workshops will take place one evening per week in Ipswich and reporting can be done anywhere.
